FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

The application, testimony and evidence comprising the record of this case are hereby included by reference in this decision. Based on the record, the Board authorized the conditional use, and variance if necessary, provided customers be requested to park on the premises—not elsewhere to the detriment of adjacent businesses. The pertinent findings determining the Board's decision include the facts that the business will be conducted similar to a furniture store with booths for display, principally, of antique furniture, antiques, collectibles and possibly some crafts; sales will be by employees; although the existing parking facilities may not comply with the provisions of the zoning ordinance, including a site development plan, the facilities appear to be adequate for this use; and, there is little likelihood that the business will unduly affect adjacent businesses, preclude future use of the building for "I-G" General Industrial District uses, or public interests.
