FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

The application, testimony and evidence comprising the record of this case are hereby included by reference in this decision. Based on the record, the Board authorized the request. The pertinent findings determining the Board's decision include the facts that the two existing buildings were authorized for use as antique shops in Cases 1125 and 3825. Therefore, the addition of arts and crafts is merely an intensification of the use of the property. In conjunction with the addition of the arts and crafts shops, the parking area will be enlarged to provide more parking spaces. A revised plot plan depicting the additional parking spaces must be submitted to the zoning administrator for approval, and the Board of Zoning Appeals for filing with this case. Conditions of authorization imposed in Cases 1125 and 3825 that are not superseded by this decision remain in effect. In considering the various factors expressed in Article 17, Section 17.7 of Ordinance 1E governing conditional uses, the Board finds that the conditional use is in accord with the purpose of the zoning ordinance, and that there is no evidence that the authorization will unduly affect the residents of adjacent properties, the values of those properties, or the public interests.
