FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

The application, testimony and evidence comprising the record of this case are hereby included by reference in this decision. Based on the record and in accordance with the state Open Meetings Act, the Board approved the conditional use and variances necessary for establishment of the one-chair beauty shop within the dwelling. The pertinent findings determining the Board's decision include the facts that the principal use of the property will continue to be the residence, which complies with the minimum rear yard requirement; the shop will be operated solely by the applicant, possibly on a full-time basis, excluding Sundays, but more likely on a part-time basis; there has been no vehicular traffic safety problems with the use-in-common driveway serving the residents since its construction some eleven years ago; and, there is no evidence that establishment of the beauty shop, as proposed, will unduly affect residents of adjacent properties, the values of those properties, or public interests.
