FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

On January 4, 2001, the Board of Zoning Appeals (the Board) convened to hear the application of Randi Place (the Applicant) for a conditional use for a Bed and Breakfast Inn in her existing home. The Applicant' home is a rambling rancher situated on 10 acres and with two barns and three fenced pastures for horses. The property is surrounded by trees and backs up the Liberty Watershed area offering horseback riding trails. Three bedrooms would be available for rent and no physical changes are proposed to the subject property. The Applicant would live at the residence and plans to have no employees. The Applicant plans to offer accommodations for overnight stays to persons travelling with horses. The Applicant feels this would be a unique and successful venture. The proposed name of the establishment would be Americana Country Bed and Breakfast.

The Board finds that the proposed use at this location will generate little or no adverse effects and have no impact on the surrounding properties. It will create no additional traffic to the area. The Board hereby approves the use as requested.
